MEETING VENUE:

Currency:

CZK (Kč) Czech crown (česká koruna)
1 EUR = 26 CZK
1 USD = 23 CZK

It is necessary to change some amount of the Czech crowns (there is a possibility of exchange at the airport), because only Czech crowns are acceptable in public transportations as well as in some small shops (without possibility to pay by card). Many shops, restaurants as well as tourist centres accept Euros. But you may get change in Czech crowns.
Please use only official exchange offices.

Public shuttle bus (the service is available only on a pre-booking basis)

Airport Shuttle

Bus no. 119 to metro station "Dejvicka", from here metro line A to station "MUZEUM" and change to line C direction Haje, exit at station "BUDĚJOVICKÁ".
The price of the bus ticket: 60 CZK (the ticket can be bought at the bus driver)
Then you need to buy another single ticket for metro (90 minutes/adult = 32 CZK)

Ticket for metro: Passengers are obliged to buy and validate a ticket before entering the metro platform. The ticket is always valid from the moment of its marking (the marking



machines are in the metro, on the trams and buses) - it is enough to mark it once. If you fail to use a ticket, you may be imposed a fine of up to CZK 1,500.

Metro operates daily from 5.00 am till midnight.

The Prague metro is the most commonly used transport mean in Prague. There are three main lines: Line A (green), Line B (yellow), Line C (red). The meeting venue is at metro line C (red) – station BUDEJOVICKA.

Transportation from the main bus station

Enter metro line C station "FLORENC" HÁJE direction, exit at station "BUDĚJOVICKÁ".

Transportation from the main railway station

Enter metro line C station "HOME STATION" HÁJE direction, exit at station "BUDĚJOVICKÁ".


The prices of the tickets (metro, buses, trams):

90 minutes/adult = 32 CZK

30 minutes/adult = 24 CZK

1 day/adult = 110 CZK

3 days/adult = 310 CZK





Taxi

Time zone

Central European Time (CET), from April to October - summer time (GMT + 1, GMT + 2)

Climate

Temperate, four seasons, a mix of ocean and inland climate, changeable winters, warm summers. The average daily temperature in January, the coldest of winter months is about -2°C, in July, the warmest month, about 20°C.

The beginning of October brings more rain and the average daily temperature falls to 10°C.

Electrical Plug and Voltage: 230 V/50 hz

The standard voltage is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.

Electrical sockets (outlets) in the Czech Republic are one of the two European standard electrical socket types: The "Type C" Europlug and the "Type E" and "Type F" Schuko. If your appliance's plug doesn't match the shape of these sockets, you will need a travel plug adapter in order to plug in. You can use your electric appliances in the Czech Republic, if the standard voltage in your country is in between 220 - 240 V (as is in the UK, Europe, Australia and most of Asia and Africa). If the standard voltage in your country is in the range of 100 V - 127 V (as is in the US, Canada and most South American countries), you need a voltage converter in the Czech Republic.
