## Ethical implications of health care priorities and missed nursing care in a Nordic context

Nurses are often responsible for the care of many patients simultaneously and have to prioritise their daily nursing care activities. The inability to provide all the care patients need may lead nurses to face certain professional challenges or moral dilemmas. This workshop will address ethical issues of missed nursing care. It will focus on the relationship between ethics, priority and missed nursing care in a Nordic context and will address issues relating to patient safety.

**From Airport to Aarhus City:** Bus directly from Aarhus Airport or Billund Airport to Aarhus central train station. See website for timetables.

**From Aarhus train station to VIA University College:** Board Tram T2 from Aarhus Train Station to end-stop at Skejby Hospital. VIA University College, Hedeager 2, 8200 Aarhus is within walking distance of 100 meters (see signs). Tram ride takes approximately 25 minutes. Price: Approximately 22 DKK (3 Euro). Runs every 5-10 minutes.

### Hotels

All of the hotels listed below are within walking distance from the bus stop where you will arrive with the bus from Billund Airport or Aarhus Airport. Each participant should make sure to book some time in advance.

### **Wakeup Aarhus**

A budget friendly hotel close to the centre of Aarhus, the main railway station and bus services. A two-night stay in a standard room for one person with flexible booking is 1.400 DKK (approximately 187 euros).
